


Helpful Note for Parents

The corruption of human seed is not simply physical; death is a product of sin.

In other words, you produce spiritually dead children.

Because God's children are born by the power of His incorruptible word, the gospel, they will never die.

Luke 1:37

For nothing will be impossible with God.

Literally...

"Because not any word of God will lack power."

And this is the word, the gospel preached to you.

Humanity congratulates itself for its great accomplishments, but all of its glory is like the flower that is here and gone.

Psalm 49:16-19

Do not be afraid when a man becomes rich, When the glory of his house is increased; For when he dies he will carry nothing away; His glory will not descend after him. Though while he lives he congratulates himself— And though men praise you when you do well for yourself— He shall go to the generation of his fathers; They shall never see the light.

The gospel radiates unfading glory

The glory of man is temporary.

The glory of the gospel will shine eternally.

1 Peter 1:24-25

The grass withers, and the flower falls off,
But the word of the Lord abides forever."
And this is the word, the gospel preached to you.

The gospel holds out to you now and forever the beauty and glory of God's infinite goodness.

Implication

It is the glory seen in the gospel that stirs the heart to love God and to love one another.

An awakening to spiritual craving Our flesh craves the world.

1 Peter 2:11

Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts, which wage war against the soul.

1 John 2:16

For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world.

An awakening to spiritual craving

Our flesh craves the world.

Grace-awakened babies crave the Word.

1 Peter 2:1-3

Therefore, putting aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, like newborn babes, long for the pure milk of the word, that by it you may grow in respect to salvation, if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord.

Ephesians 2:4-7

But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places, in Christ Jesus, in order that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Grace-Awakened Babies

1 Peter 2:1-3
