- What questions might you ask to help them think about their life in light of this passage?

1 John 1:5-6

- What does this passage say about God?
- What is meant by "light"?
- What does this passage say is expected of us in order to be in fellowship with God?
- How might you use this passage to help people see the problem they face in their efforts to come to God?
- What questions might you ask to help them think about their life in light of this passage?

Romans 3:23

- What does this passage say about people? Will people likely agree with this?
- What does this passage say is the standard that defines sin?
- What is the "glory of God"? How might you help someone understand what this means?
- Why is this important for the person to accept?
- What questions might you ask to help them think about their life in light of this?
