But Jesus says...

Matthew 6:24 No one can serve two masters.

Literally this says, "No one can be the slave of two lords." Implication? You belong to someone else!

Psalm 119:94 "I am Yours, save me!"

Job 33:6 Behold, **I belong to God** like you; I too have been formed out of the clay.

John 1:12

How will you know?

You will know because... You will love your <u>true</u> master and hate the other.

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What does Jesus mean by "love" and "hate"?

Luke 14:26

If anyone comes to Me, and does not **hate** his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be My disciple.

Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

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Matthew 10:37

He who loves father or mother **more than Me** is not worthy of Me; and he who loves son or daughter **more than Me** is not worthy of Me.

If you love Christ **more**, you will be willing to forsake your precious things for Him.

But if you love your precious things **more**, you will become angry or sullen if He asks you to forsake them or to give them back.

You will know because...

You will love your true master and hate the other.

You will **devote** yourself to your <u>true</u> master and **despise** the other.
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You cannot serve God and mammon.

To devote yourself to someone is to give yourself to that person for service.

Matthew 6:24 No one can **Serve** two masters... ...You cannot **Serve** God and mammon.

To despise a master is to dismiss his authority with contempt.

1 Timothy 4:11-12 Prescribe and teach these things. Let no **despise** your youthfulness...

If you are devoted to Christ as your master, you will gladly obey Him no matter the cost.

But if you are devoted to your precious things, you will disobey Christ to keep them.

So what can we say? Your actions will betray your idols. Your attitudes will betray your idols. Your emotions will betray your idols.
