## Week Six

**Q6:** How can we glorify God?

**A6:** We glorify God by enjoying Him, loving Him, trusting Him, and by obeying His will, commands, and law

**Deuteronomy 11:1** You shall therefore love the Lord your God and keep his charge, his statutes, his rules, and his commandments always.

Discuss the question:

- What is our purpose in life? Think back to week four.
- What does the term to glorify God mean? And how do we do it?
- Why is it important that we glorify God?

Discuss the Scripture:

- How do we show our love for God?
- What does it mean to, “Keep his charge, his statutes, his rules, and his commandments always.”
- What feelings, thoughts, and emotions come to mind when you read this verse?
- As we seek to glorify God what is important for us to remember about our attitude?

Discuss the answer in light of the Scripture:

- Are we commanded to enjoy God in the Bible?
- How do we enjoy God?
- How do we show our love for God?
- What do we need to trust the Lord in?
- The answer mentions obeying God’s will. What is God’s will for the Christian?
- What does obedience look like? What about the heart of the matter?
- Why does this answer lump in God’s will with commands and laws?

*What is keeping you from giving these areas of your life up to God?*
