



Leviticus 20:23-24 and 26

“Moreover, you shall not follow the customs of the nation which I shall drive out before you, for they did all these things, and therefore I have abhorred them. Hence I have said to you, ‘You are to possess their land, and I Myself will give it to you to possess it, a land flowing with milk and honey.’
I am the LORD your God,
who has separated you from the peoples.”

Verse 26

“Thus you are to be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy.”

*Separation from the world is not
isolation from the world.*

It is choosing to be different.

Leviticus 11:44-45


For I am the LORD your God.

Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy; for I am holy.

And you shall not make yourselves unclean with any of the swarming things that swarm on the earth.

For I am the LORD, who brought you up from the land of Egypt, to be your God; thus you shall be holy for I am holy.

*Consecration is purification
for a purpose.*



Exodus 28:41

And you shall put them on Aaron your brother and on his sons with him; and you shall anoint them and ordain them and consecrate them, that they may serve Me as priests.

*God has chosen you and purified
you for the purpose of making
His holy character known.*

1 Peter 2:9

Why the command?


Because we are children of the Holy One.



By Spirit-effected perfection then.


1 Peter 1:14-16
