

Sexual Sins Greed Gluttony Laziness People Pleasing Fleshly lusts are the selfish desires that wage war for the control and domination of your soul.

1 Peter 2:11-12

Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven. You testify to your Father's goodness when you allow His good character to visibly flow out from you to others.

Seek for the glory of God!

1 Peter 2:11-12

Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul, keeping your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may on account of your good deeds, as they observe them, glorify God in the day of visitation. Peter assumes **you** are glorifying God, but God's intention is for you to go beyond personal worship and to lead the unbelievers around you to give glory.

But what is God's glory?

Seeking God's glory

God's glory refers to the perfections of His nature and character.

Aspects of God's glory that we can display

Exodus 34:6-7

Then the LORD passed by in front of *Moses* and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth; who keeps lovingkindness for thousands, who forgives iniquity, transgression and sin; yet He will by no means leave the guilty unpunished...

Seeking God's glory

God's glory refers to the perfections of His nature and character.

God intends for your life to make Him look glorious.

But you are God's Beloved!

Your true identity
