And Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you **be baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

1 Peter 3:21

And corresponding to that, **baptism** now saves you -- not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience-- through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Romans 6:4

Therefore we have been buried with Him **through baptism** into death, in order that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.

1 Corinthians 12:13

For by one Spirit we were all **baptized** into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. Baptism has been given to us as a sign of our belonging to God and signifies several realities of life in Christ.

As a sign, what does baptism signify?

Baptism signifies repentance.

Repentance is a change of mind and heart toward Jesus.

And Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Baptism is NOT repentance... ...but it is a response that makes repentance visible.

What does baptism signify?

Baptism signifies repentance.

Baptism signifies submission to Christ as Lord.

Acts 2:36 and 38 "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christthis Jesus whom you crucified." And Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

To be Lord is to be master, to be **the** authority.

Acts 2:36 and 38

"Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christthis Jesus whom you crucified."

And Peter said to them,

"Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name

of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Baptism is **NOT** submission...

...but it **is** a response that makes submission visible.

What does baptism signify?

Baptism signifies repentance.

Baptism signifies submission to Christ as Lord.

Baptism signifies forgiveness of sin.

and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Baptism is NOT the place of forgiveness... ...but it is where forgiveness is made visible.

Baptism is not the place of forgiveness.

1 Peter 3:21

And corresponding to that, baptism now saves you -- not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience-- through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Sin is washed away when a person repents and appeals to God for a clean conscience.

Baptism is the visible sign of this washing of forgiveness.

What does baptism signify?

Baptism signifies repentance.

Baptism signifies submission to Christ as Lord.

Baptism signifies forgiveness of sin.

Baptism signifies our union with Christ.

Romans 6:4-5

Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, in order that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have become united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection.

Baptism does NOT unite us to Christ... ...but it is the visible sign of that union.

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Baptism signifies our union with Christ in His death and burial.

Romans 6:4-5

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of the Father, SO we too might walk in newness of life.

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Baptism signifies our union with Christ in His resurrection to life.

What does baptism signify?

Baptism signifies repentance.

Baptism signifies submission to Christ as Lord.

Baptism signifies forgiveness of sin.

Baptism signifies our union with Christ.

Baptism signifies our union with the church.

1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. Baptism does NOT unite us to the church... ...but it is a sign of our immersion into the body of Christ, which is the church.

Baptism identifies us as God's people: It signifies that we belong to Him, that we have life in Him, and that we belong to one another.
