THE DUTIES OF COVENANT MEMBERSHIP

1. For members:

- a. Protect the gospel.
 - i. In my own life (Philippians 1:27).
 - ii. In my church (Galatians).
- b. Pray for my church family (Romans 12:12).
- c. Gather regularly (Hebrews 10:25).
- d. Seek to make connections that will be mutually beneficial in discipleship (Romans 1:11-12; 2 Timothy 2:22).
- e. Find ways to serve the body (Galatians 5:13; 1 Peter 4:10).
- f. Share:
 - i. My faith (evangelism)
 - ii. My heart
 - iii. My resources
 - iv. My need
- g. Love my church family:
 - i. Rejoicing with them in blessing.
 - ii. Weeping with them in hardship.
 - iii. Bearing with them in weakness.
 - iv. Forgiving them in waywardness.
 - v. Believing the best about them and hoping the best for them.
 - vi. Refusing gossip and slander in favor of commendation and encouragement.
 - vii. Pursuing peace and working for reconciliation in all things.
- h. Conduct myself in the world in a manner consistent with the gospel, pursuing holiness and denying fleshly indulgence (Philippians 1:27).
- i. Uphold justice and righteousness and love of neighbor (Matthew 23:23).

2. For Leaders:

- a. Preach and protect the gospel (2 Timothy 4:1-2; Jude 3)
- b. Shepherd the flock (1 Peter 5:1-3; Ezekiel 34)
 - i. Feed them faithfully.
 - ii. Strengthen the weak.
 - iii. Bind up the broken.
 - iv. Heal the sick.
 - v. Gather the scattered.
 - vi. Look for the lost.
