Courage in Persecution Be sure you are suffering for the right reason.

Persecution for the right reason:

Do not be persecuted as an evil doer.

1 Peter 4:15-17

Do not let any of you suffer as a murderer, or thief, or evildoer, or a troublesome meddler; but if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this respect. For it is time for judgment to begin with the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?

Is it possible that your persecution is really only the consequence of your bad behavior?

Persecution for the right reason:

Do not be persecuted as an evil doer.

Be persecuted as a Christian.

1 Peter 4:15-17

Do not let any of you suffer as a murderer, or thief, or evildoer, or a troublesome meddler;

but if anyone suffers as a Christian,

let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this respect. For it is time for judgment to begin with the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God? Christians will make decisions that run counter to the prevailing culture causing friction with an intolerant world.

1 Peter 4:18

And if it is with difficulty that the righteous is saved, what will become of the godless man and the sinner?

Great temptations and hardships make the Christian life difficult, and it is only the power of God that guards the believer's soul through it.

1 Peter 1:5

...who are **protected by the power of God** through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

Malachi 3:1-3

The judgment of God has begun with His house, His royal priesthood, and He is using the "fire" of persecution and suffering to test her and purify her for the judgment to come.

Beloved, do not be surprised at the **fiery ordeal** among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you.

God has always begun His work of purification from within His house.

Understanding God's plan for judgment

God has begun His judgment from within the Church.

God is delaying **final** judgment for the unbeliever to the end.

Final Judgment

1 Peter 4:17-18

For it is time for judgment to begin with the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God? And if it is with difficulty that the righteous is saved, what will become of the godless man and the sinner?

Proverbs 11:31

If the righteous are being saved with difficulty, How <u>will</u> the wicked and the sinner appear!

God preserves those whom He has made righteous, but the wicked and the sinner will not stand in the judgment.

The word for "entrust" was a commercial technical term for giving something to someone in trust for safekeeping.

in doing what is right

Doing right, especially when it conflicts with the currents of culture, indicates that you are entrusting your soul to your faithful Creator.

Conclusion:

When you entrust your soul to Christ and believe that He knows what He is doing, you will have courage to endure and will glorify God even in your sufferings.
