1 Corinthians 12:7

But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

1 Corinthians 12:11

But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.

Ephesians 4:7

But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.

In keeping with God's provisions

God has gifted every believer.

God has provided a great diversity of gifts according to His grace.

According to His Grace

1 Peter 4:10 As each one has received a gift,

employ it in serving one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

The unique and special abilities God has given you as His child are not a credit to you but are manifestations of His grace to you.

1 Corinthians 4:7

For who regards you as superior? And what do you have that you did not receive? But if you did receive it, why do you boast as if you had not received it? According to His grace, God provides **a diversity of gifts** in keeping with His sovereignty.

A Diversity of Gifts

1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a gift, employ it in serving one another,

as good stewards of the **manifold grace** of God.

Manifold = multi-colored, diverse.

Romans 12:6 And since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us...

1 Corinthians 12:11

But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.

In His infinite wisdom and in keeping with His purposes, God has gifted every believer for faithful service. This gifting is amazingly diverse such that every believer has a unique part in God's purposes.

What are God's purposes?

God has purposed to build His church with your gifting.

Building His Church

1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a gift,

employ it in <u>Serving</u> one another,

as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Sacrificial service is a natural outflow of love and an indication of our union with Christ.

Mark 10:45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

Your gifting is God's provision to the church for the purpose of building each other up in Christ. Ephesians 4:15-16 ...but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him, who is the head, even Christ, from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by that which every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love. Faithful service is purposeful service. Is your service aimed at building up the body of Christ.

What are God's purposes?

God has purposed to build His church with your gifting.

God has purposed to bring Himself glory through your gifting.

Twofold Division

All who preach and teach are called to do so with great care for precision, understanding that they proclaim God's message and not their own.

2 Peter 1:20-21

But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God. In this current age of the Church, all speaking ministries must be rooted and grounded exclusively in the Word of God.
