Our Lord Jesus Christ

You must embrace Jesus Christ as Lord.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

The phrase "our Lord" is used of Jesus over **70x** in the New Testament! The designation "our Lord", is a clear and bold proclamation of Jesus' deity and authority!

It is rooted in Old Testament heritage.

Nehemiah 8:10 ...for this day is holy to **our Lord**. Do not be grieved, for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

Nehemiah 10:29 ...and to keep and to observe all the commandments of God **our Lord**, and His ordinances and His statutes.

It is rooted in Old Testament heritage.

Psalm 8:1

O LORD, **our Lord**, How majestic is Your name in all the earth, Who have displayed Your splendor above the heavens!

Psalm 135:5

For I know that the LORD is great, And that **our Lord** is above all gods.

Jesus "our Lord" is to say, "Jesus our Jehovah"! Jesus cannot be separated from His identity as Lord, so you cannot receive Him in any other way. Romans 10:8-9 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" -- that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. But you must also believe that Jesus was raised from the dead because His resurrection proves that He is LORD.

Romans 10:8-9

But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" -- that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord,

and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead,

you will be saved.

His resurrection proves that His work as our perfect mediator is effective.

Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.

Jesus' death was necessary to fulfill the prophecy of a Christ who must suffer.

His resurrection proves that He is the Messiah, the Savior of His people, the eternal Son and King.
