
A Task Unfinished

Stand firm in it!

Peter exhorted them through his letter.

His exhortation was that we have a salvation given to us by the God of all grace, and we stand because of His grace and by His grace.

Peter's Exhortation

1 Peter 1:3-5

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

His Exhortation

1 Peter 1:13

Therefore, gird your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

Silvanus was faithful to the mission by delivering this exhortation to these churches by way of Peter's letter.

We still share the same mission!

Exhort one another!

Therefore **exhort one another**, and build up one another, just as you also are doing.

Exhort one another!

Hebrews 3:13

But **exhort one another** day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," lest any one of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

Exhort one another!

Hebrews 10:24-25

And let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but **exhorting one another**; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.

Our Mission

Exhort one another in the gospel.

Testify to the grace of God.

1 Peter 5:12-14

Stand firm in it!

Peter's letter testifies or bears witness that the true grace of God is found in the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Peter's Testimony

1 Peter 1:18-21

...knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

For He was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you who through Him are believers in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

What about Testimonies?

Your mission is to testify to the true grace of God found in the death and resurrection of Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 2:1-2

And when I came to you, brethren,
I did not come with superiority of speech or of wisdom,

proclaiming to you the testimony of God.

For I determined to know nothing among you except **Jesus Christ**, and Him **crucified**.

Revelation 6:9

And when He broke the fifth seal,
I saw underneath the altar the souls of those
who had been slain because of the word of God,
and because of the testimony which they had maintained.

Stand Firm in Grace

By definition, to stand firm in *grace* is to reject the belief that you can stand firm in anything of yourself.

Luke 18:11-12

The Pharisee stood and was praying thus to himself, "God, I thank You that I am not like other people: swindlers, unjust, adulterers, or even like this tax-gatherer. I fast twice a week; I pay tithes of all that I get."

Isaiah 64:6

For all of us have become like one who is unclean,
And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment;
And all of us wither like a leaf,
And our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

Satan is content to leave you with strong morals and religious fervor so long as you believe that these will earn you God's favor.

Stand Firm in Grace

Resist self-righteousness.

Resolve to receive God's gift.

1 Peter 5:12

"Stand firm" is a command yet grace is a gift!

Grace is a Gift

Romans 3:24

...being justified as **a gift by His grace** through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 2:8

For **by grace** you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, **it is the gift of God**.

Ephesians 4:7

But to each one of us **grace** was given according to the measure of Christ's **gift**.

We live in a tension between the hidden works of God's grace and our will to act.

Stand Firm Is a Command

1 Peter 1:13

Therefore, gird your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

A Gift!

1 Peter 1:13

Therefore, gird your minds for action, keep sober in spirit,

fix your hope completely On the **grace** to be brought

to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

You will not stand if you are not standing in and by grace!
