A culture of discipleship exists when it's normal for Christians to be sound in the faith, living as godly examples, and deliberately using their lives and relationships to help each other follow Jesus.

Biblical Discipleship

Matthew 28:18-20

"18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and **teaching them to obey** everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Culture: The shared ideas, attitudes, and beliefs that characterize a group and shape the way they function

Discipleship: Helping others follow Jesus

Culture of Discipleship: A gospel community in which discipleship is normal and expected among all members

Titus 2:1-8 (NASB)

A: Faith/ Election (grace) is according to the knowledge of the truth (sound doctrine) and leads to godliness (1:1-2)

B: Appoint elders as examples of godliness and teachers of sound doctrine (1:5-9)

C: Older men are to be examples of godliness in accordance with sound doctrine (2:2)

D: Older Women are to be examples of godliness and able to instruct (train) (2:3)

D': Younger women are to be godly after the example of older women (2:4)

C': Younger men are to be godly after the example of older men (2:6)

B': The pastor/elder is to be an example of godliness and a teacher of sound doctrine (2:7-8)

A': The grace of God (election) that brings salvation teaches us to say "no" to ungodliness & yes to godliness (2:11-12)

Elders, set an example for the church.

Christians are called to live godly lives in accordance with sound doctrine...

Church, follow the example of your elders.

The elder must be "holding fast the faithful word which is in accordance with the teaching, so that he will be able both

to exhort in sound doctrine and to refute those who contradict."

13... "For this reason reprove them severely

so that they may be sound in the faith"

In a culture of discipleship, the elders will protect and present **sound doctrine** as that which **is**:

Essential for the hope of eternal life

Necessary to protect the church from harm

Sufficient in leading to wholeness
