Our order of worship reflects the gospel pattern of hearing and responding: God calls us, revealing Himself to us; we respond in exultation that gives way to confession and contrition. By the mercies of God, offer yourselves to Him and worship Him with your life.

Believers go forth and proclaim the excellencies of Christ by declaring His gospel with their mouths and by displaying its truth with their lives.

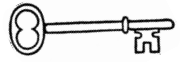

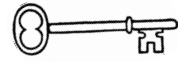
