## Service Order - May 31, 2020

Our order of worship reflects the gospel pattern of hearing and responding: God calls us, revealing Himself to us; we respond in exultation that gives way to confession and contrition. God forgives and assures us; we respond with thanksgiving and professions of faith, with petitions and offerings. God instructs and charges us; we respond by going forth to declare and display His goodness.

It is good and right to prepare ourselves to worship, to quiet our souls and direct our hearts to know that He is God.





**Word #2**  
**No Images or Idols**

Deuteronomy 5:8-10

The second Word reminds us of the pure and uncontainable nature of God  
and requires that we worship Him in spirit and in truth.

1. What does the 2<sup>nd</sup> Word teach about the LORD?
