## The Work of Grace

Titus 2:11-14

The Lord's sovereign grace decisively initiates, empowers, and fulfills the Christian life

- Grace accomplishes our salvation (vs 11)
  - Grace has been active in election from eternity past
  - Grace becomes visible when salvation is applied
  
- Grace empowers our sanctification (vs 12)
  - Grace teaches/trains us to deny ungodliness and worldly passions
  - Grace teaches/ trains us to live self-controlled, godly lives
    - When we understand grace, we respond in a certain way and it has an effect
    - But more than that, grace is divine power that makes these efforts effective
  
- Grace changes our desires (vs 12, 14)
  - A desire for Jesus Himself
  - Zeal for doing what is good
  
- Grace enables our perseverance (vs 13)
  - Grace empowers us to wait in the present age
  - Grace empowers us to await (cherish, welcome, anticipate, long for) the blessed hope
