Main Idea

Christ is your only doorway into God's kingdom, your only Shepherd who knows you fully, and your only source of life and its abundance.

This is another way of saying that
Jesus is the *only* way to the Father.

Remember that the Exodus has been the backdrop of John's gospel, and Jesus has held Himself out as the new and better Moses leading His people into the land of promise, the land of abundance, God's glorious kingdom of priests.

Jesus obeyed God's voice and kept the covenant on behalf of His people and has thereby rescued us from the domain of darkness and has transferred us into His glorious kingdom of light!

Christ is your Door

Going in and out is a Hebrew way of indicating a freedom and familiarity of movement that encompasses all of life.

Pasturelands represent provision, satisfaction, comfort, enjoyment, delight.

Those who go in and out through Christ will find all the nourishment and refreshment their souls need.

Now he did not say this on his own initiative, but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus was going to die for the nation, and not for the nation only, but in order that He might also gather together into one the children of God who are scattered abroad.

Now he did not say this on his own initiative, but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus was going to die for the nation, and not for the nation only, but in order **that He might also gather together into one the children of God who are scattered abroad.**

Jesus laid down His life on behalf of all His sheep, Jew and Gentile, and He has gathered them together into one new people in one new covenant in one new kingdom.

He will continue to guard all His own!

The life that Jesus gives is not mere existence, as if that were all that we consider to be life.

Christ is your Life

He came to give you life.

He is your source for *abundant* life.

John 10:10

“I came that they may have life,
and have it abundantly.”

What is abundant life?

The abundance of life is not the filling up of temporal and material pleasures but the filling up of the soul with spiritual blessings, the delights of God seen in and experienced through Christ.

Psalm 37:4

Delight yourself in the LORD;
And He will give you the desires of your heart.

Colossians 2:2-3

...that their hearts may be encouraged, having been knit together in love, and attaining to all the wealth that comes from the full assurance of understanding, resulting in a true knowledge of God's mystery, that is, Christ Himself, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Ephesians 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing
in the heavenly places in Christ.

Concluding Questions

Christ is the only doorway to the Father
