Main Idea

Your eternal salvation, eternal security, and eternal felicity are all grounded in Christ and in the good news of His redemption.

This commandment I received from My Father.”

This command – that Christ lay down His life and take it up again– is shorthand for the *eternal covenant of redemption*, in which God promised the Son a people and commissioned and sent Him to save them.

Christ's work

Jesus' response to this command?

Jesus laid down His life on behalf of the sheep the Father had given Him in order to save them and give them life by fulfilling all the requirements of God's covenant for them.

**The ground of your salvation
is Christ's work, not yours!**

Faith in Christ

The joy of your salvation
begins by believing Christ and
then resting in Him!

Will you believe Him?

Do you believe this?

If you are to enter the lush
pasturelands and experience the
abundant life that Christ offers you,
you must believe Him.

That is, you must believe that *what
He declares good, is indeed good!*

Christ's upside-down world...

Luke 9:24

“For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it,
but whoever loses his life for My sake,
he is the one who will save it.”

Our problem is that we cling to what
we believe is life to us, and we fear
entrusting our happiness to Christ.

Bear this in mind:

*Christ has made faith in Him
the pathway into His blessings.*

In other words, the Lord will not give you
the blessings of faith until you believe.

James 1:5-8

Delight in Christ

Remember what Jesus has said of Himself.

“I am the source of living water.” (4:10)

“I am the bread of life.” (6:35)

“I am the Light of the world.” (8:12)

“I am the good Shepherd.” (10:11)

These statements all refer to Christ as the source and caretaker of life—***He*** is the Fountain of your delights.

Psalm 37:4

Delight yourself in the LORD;
And He will give you the desires of your heart.

What keeps us from delighting in Christ?

Ignorant familiarity

Latent Ingratitude

Stubborn Discontent

Subtle Disbelief

Persistent Worry

Worldly pursuits

How can you learn to delight in Christ?

Learn to meditate on Christ Himself.

Learn to convert even your mundane activities into worship.

Learn to prepare for corporate worship.
