And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize **the full assurance of hope** until the end.

We are to draw near to God with a confident faith that flows from a sincere heart, believing God to be faithful and trusting that He will meet us in our time of need.

James 1:6-8

But he must ask in faith without any doubting, for the one who doubts is like the surf of the sea, driven and tossed by the wind. For that man ought not to expect that he will receive anything from the Lord, being a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

To be double-minded is to have mixed allegiances or alternate sources of hope.

Then he shall bathe his body in water
and put them on.

Just as priests were washed before entering the presence of the Lord, so we have been washed as priests, made to be part of the royal priesthood, fitted to enter into the holy place.

1 Peter 2:9

But you are *a chosen race, a royal **priesthood**,
a holy nation, a people for God's own possession.*

This washing for our priesthood
is signified in our baptism.
