If Revelation 20 chronologically follows Revelation 19 and occurs at the end of the age, this is the strongest argument for the premillennial position.

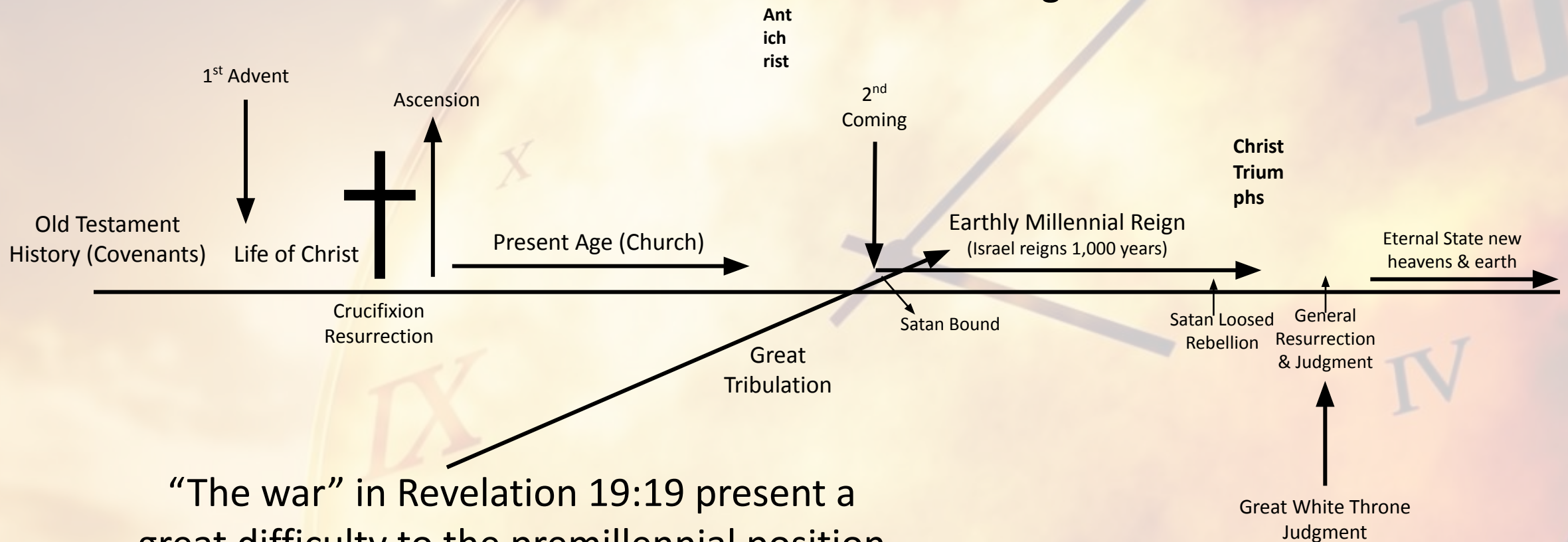

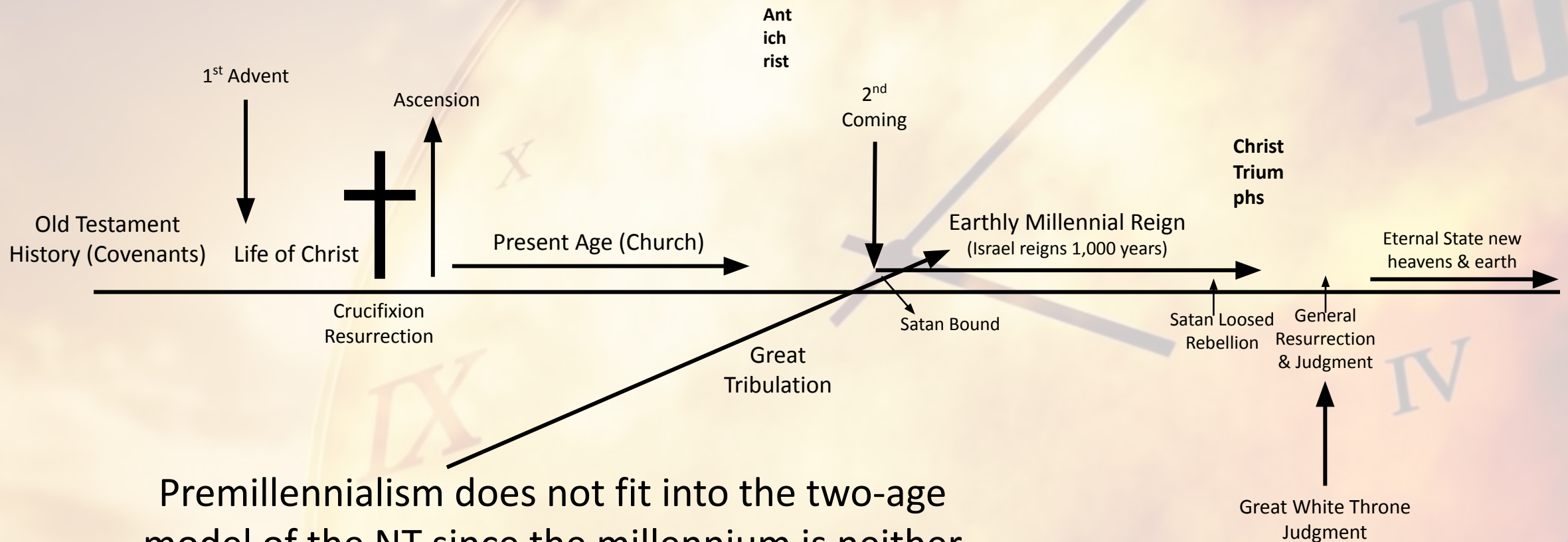
# Difficulties and Questions

Are there three “the wars” in the unfolding of Christ’s consummation?



“The war” in Revelation 19:19 present a great difficulty to the premillennial position (cf. “the war” in 16:14 and 20:8).

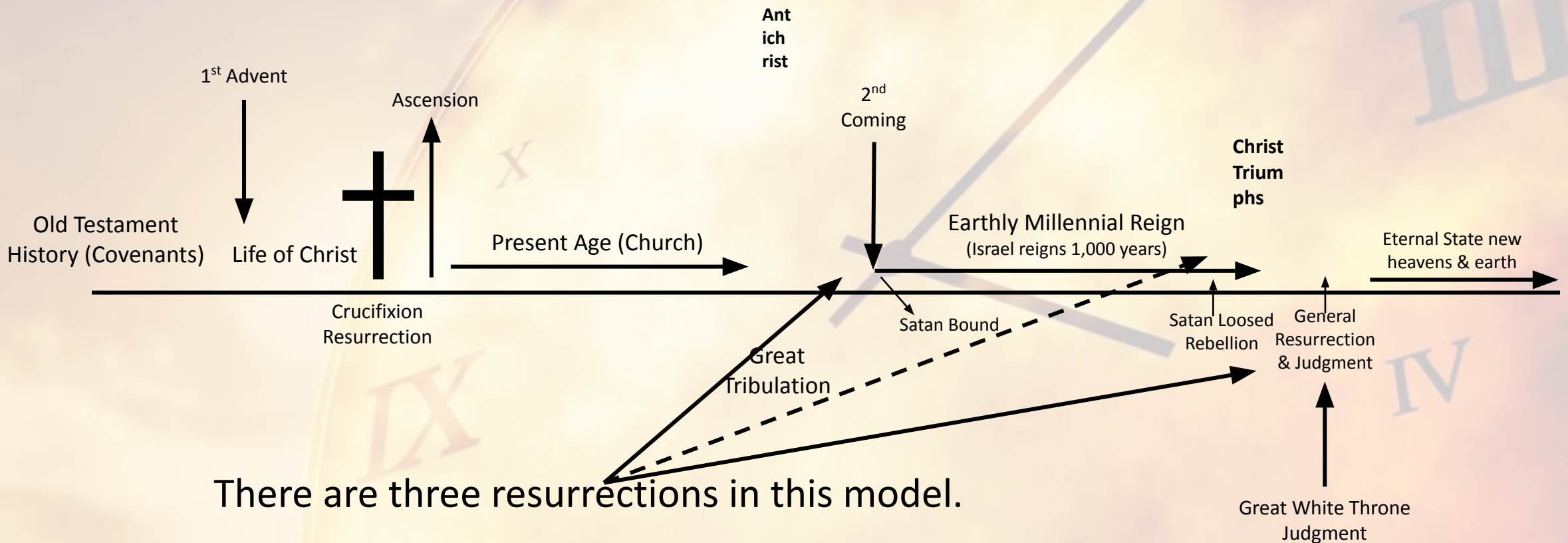
# Difficulties and Questions



Premillennialism does not fit into the two-age model of the NT since the millennium is neither “this present evil age” nor is it “the age to come.” It adds a third age.

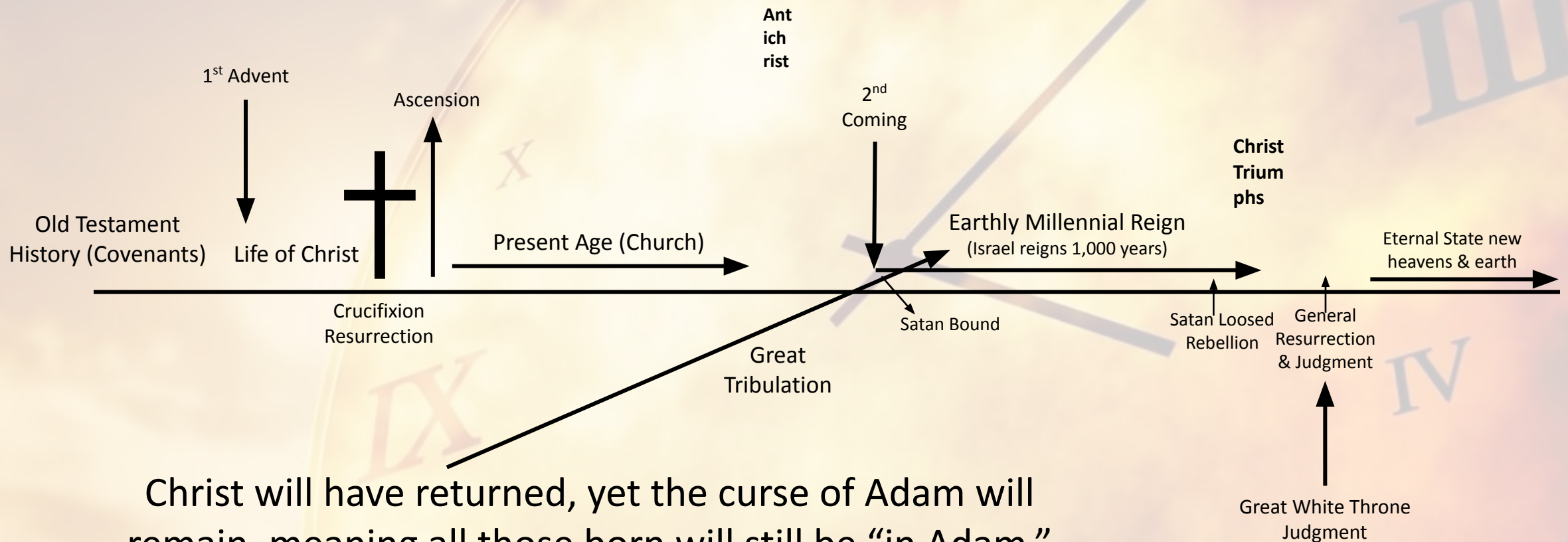


# Difficulties and Questions



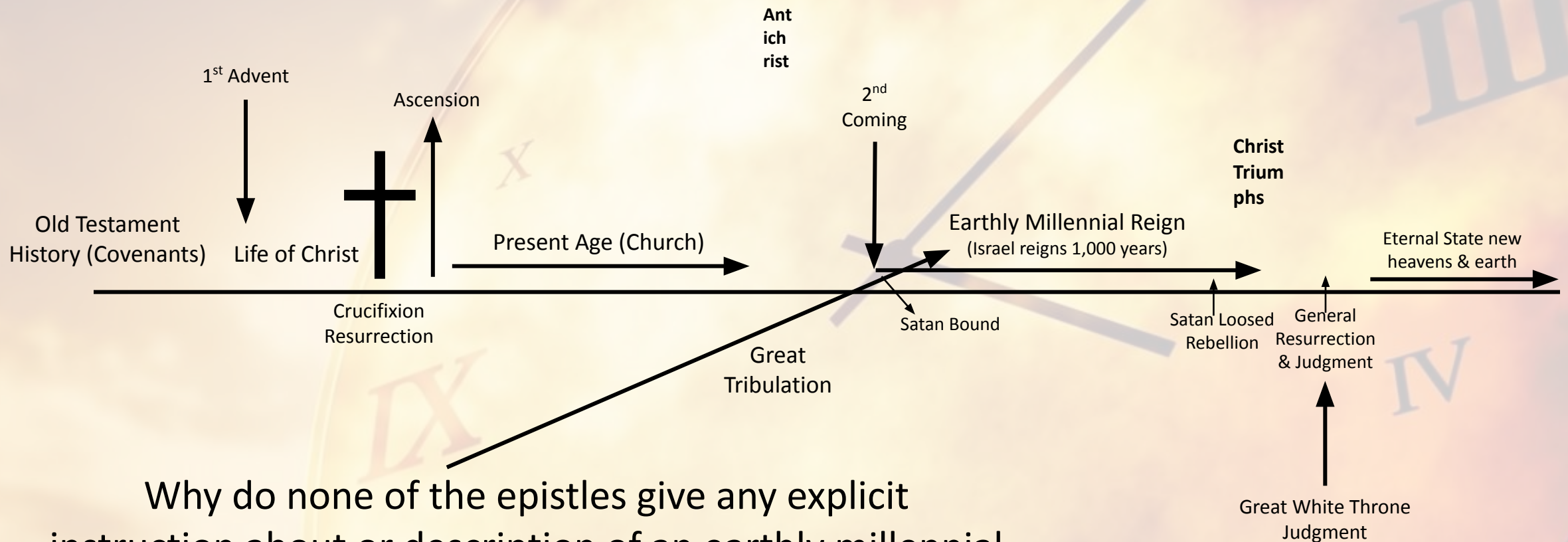
Remember, believers die in this age, and Christ is bodily reigning on the earth. What is the “intermediate state” for these believers (cf. 2 Cor. 5:8)?

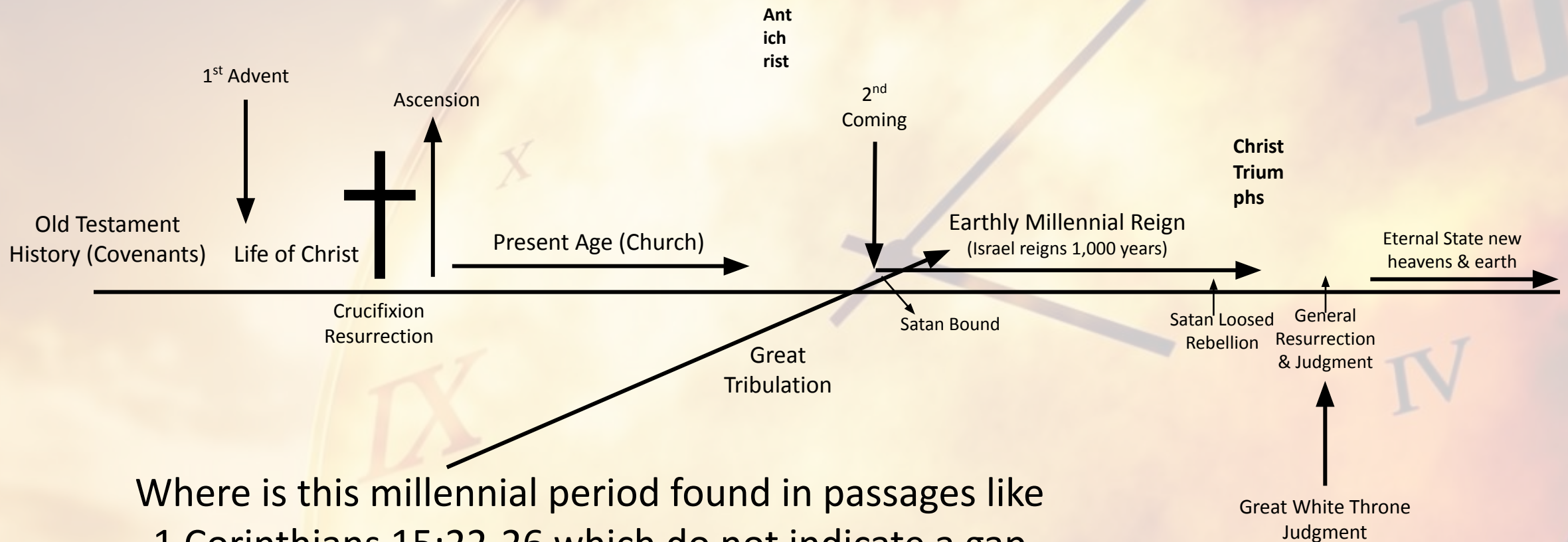
# Difficulties and Questions
