Jesus' resurrection testifies to His person, work, and authority; and this is our only sure anchor in the storms of life and death.

A Sure Anchor in the Storms The Person of Christ

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The solution to fear is knowing Christ as He is for this is the ground of what He has done in His death and resurrection.
