What is the Nature of the Church?

1. It is invisible, yet visible.

The invisible church is the church as God sees it.

The visible church is the church as we (believers) see it.

Matthew 13:24-43 2 Timothy 2:16-19 1 John 2:19

Why is it important to understand the distinction between the invisible and visible church?

2. It is universal, yet local.

The universal church is the community of all true believers for all time.

Matthew 16:18 Ep

Ephesians 5:25

Are we able to participate in the universal church now?

"A local church is a group of Christians who regularly gather in Christ's name to officially affirm and oversee one another's membership in Jesus Christ and his kingdom through gospel preaching and gospel ordinances."

"Local" = Acts 14:27; 1 Corinthians 1:2; Revelation 2-3

"Affirming" = Matthew 18:1-6; Acts 9:26-27

"Overseeing" = Matthew 18:15-17; Galatians 6:1-2; 1 Peter 5:1-3

The gathering of the universal church is something we are meant to anticipate.

The gathering of the local church is something we are meant to **experience**.
