Believers will be sanctified (growing in righteousness)

- Romans 8:28-29
 - You were predestined to grow in Christ-likeness

Hebrews 10:11-14

¹¹ And every priest stands daily at his service, offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. ¹² But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, ¹³ waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. ¹⁴ For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.

- A Corporate Calling
 - See to it (take care) brothers... (Heb 3:12)
 - Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the heavenly calling... (Heb 3:1)

A Corporate Calling

- We are called into communion (family) with God (Hebrews 2:10-14)
- We are called into communion (family) with each other (Hebrews 3:1; 12)

The reality of our adoption as children of God can't be separated from the reality that we are now brothers and sisters. We belong to God and therefore we belong to one another.

A Corporate Calling

We are God's house (Hebrews 3:1-6)

Hebrews 3:6

... we are his house, if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

1 Timothy 3:14-15

¹⁴ I hope to come to you soon, but I am writing these things to you so that, ¹⁵ if I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in *the household of God, which is the church* of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth.

1 Peter 2:4-5, 9-10

⁴ As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, ⁵ *you yourselves* like living stones *are being built up as a spiritual house*, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ... ⁹ But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now

A Corporate Calling

- We are God's house (Hebrews 3:1-6)
- God's house is the **church** (1 Tim 3:14-15)
 - The pillar and foundation of truth
 - The people and how they conduct themselves
- Not just an individual experience, but a corporate reality (1 Peter 2:4-10)

To confess faith in Christ is to declare that you are one of the living stones, gathered by God and built into a spiritual house – the Church

A Corporate Calling

Every individual must be saved through personal faith in Jesus Christ, but nobody is saved merely as an individual...

God's people are saved as a people.

The danger is that you, brothers and sisters (the Church, the house of God) can in fact be hardened by sin's deceitfulness and develop a sinful (or evil), unbelieving heart that turns away from the Lord.

Our sin wages a constant battle against us, intending to deceive us and harden our hearts in unbelief (Heb 3:12-14)

 - Why is this so dangerous?

Because no-one is exempt from this (Heb 3:7-19)

Hebrews 3:7-8, 12-16

⁷ Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "Today, if you hear his voice, ⁸ do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness...

- ¹² Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. ¹³ But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. ¹⁴ For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. ¹⁵ As it is said,

 - Why is this so dangerous?

Because no-one is exempt from this (Hebrews 3:7-19)

Because you're blind to it (Jeremiah 17:5-10, Hebrews 3:13)

- A Corporate Calling
- A Deceptive Danger
 - What does this look like?

- A sinful, unbelieving heart (vs 12)
- A hard heart (vs 13)
- Turning away (vs 12)

- A Corporate Calling
- A Deceptive Danger
 - Signs of trouble
 - You rarely, if ever, interact with other believers in a context where you're exhorting one-another.
 - When you gather, you stick to superficial conversations (the weather, the Huskers, work) but scarcely get beneath the surface
 - You think this warning doesn't apply to you
 - You aren't seeing to or exhorting anyone
 - You aren't being seen to or exhorted by anyone.

- A Deceptive Danger
- A Family Obligation
 - See to it (take care/make sure) vs 12

That no one is embracing sin

That no one is walking away in unbelief

An active responsibility (not passive or merely reactive)

- A Corporate Calling
- A Deceptive Danger
- A Family Obligation
 - Encourage (exhort) one another (vs 13)
 - With words! (God's Word)
 - Daily! (vs 13)
 - Why?
 - To protect against hardening hearts (13)
 - To help each other persevere and hold onto the hope we had at first (vs 14)

How do we do this?

- Not less than Sundays
- Not just Sundays
- Small Groups
- The orientation of our lifestyle
- Life on Life Discipleship
